New Revised Ceres Area Transit (CAT) Route B in July:

CAT Route B (Mon-Fri): There will be modifications to the route in southwest Ceres. The bus will travel further north on Crows Landing Road and then east on Whitmore Avenue, then loop back to the Ceres Library, head north to the Stanislaus Recovery Resources, and then to Hatch and Herndon.

Please note: An additional Route B bus is provided in the afternoon to better serve Central Valley High School. This bus stops at Central Valley High at 2:55 p.m. The regularly scheduled bus stops at Central Valley High 25 minutes past the hour, every hour.
