Ceres, CA – On August 14th, 2018 the Ceres Police Department was notified that Eric Sanchez-Padilla 23 Yrs, was detained at the Calexico-West port of entry. At approximately 9:30 a.m. Sanchez Padilla was escorted to the pedestrian facility by Mexican officials where he was turned over to Customs and Border Protection officers.

A query of Sanchez-Padilla's fingerprints revealed the outstanding Ceres Police Department homicide warrant. CBP officers contacted the Ceres Police Department and arrangements were made to transport Sanchez-Padilla back to Stanislaus County.

On August 22nd, 2018, Ceres Police Detectives booked Sanchez-Padilla into the Stanislaus County Jail for the outstanding homicide warrant. His arrest concludes a three year manhunt for the fugitive wanted in connection to the homicide of Derrick Farrow at Runaround Sue's bar on Mitchell Rd. in Ceres that occurred on December 26th, 2014.
