The Operator I is an entry level position, however extra weight is given to those applicants with Wastewater coursework or municipal utility experience. Ideally you have a high aptitude for maintenance work and love to be outside. The full-time work schedule is only four days per week, ten hours per day for a desired work/life balance. The City offers some 100% premium paid health benefit options as well as a generous lifetime pension after vesting.

Responsibilities may include:

- Monitor, repair and maintain system lift stations; remove debris; disassemble and clean pumps
- Inspect and make repairs to plant equipment
- Perform general grounds maintenance work
- Grease and clean plant equipment; read and interpret meters and gauges; regulate plant effluent
- Rod sanitary sewers; install and repair sanitary sewer laterals and trunk lines
