

Used Oil & Oil Filters



Pour motor oil into a plastic screw top container.

Place drained oil filters in a plastic, sealable, see-through bag.



Place used oil and filters two feet from blue can on your recycling day.

**If you do not have residential garbage service or live in an apartment complex, please contact (800)-CLEANUP for the closest oil recycle center or ask where to recycle used oil when purchasing items.

What Goes into your Blue Recycle Can?

All **recyclable** materials including:

- Paper: Computer paper, stationary, newspaper, catalogs, phone books, and boxes (No pizza boxes or milk cartons)
- Metal Cans: steel, bi-metal or aluminum.
- Glass bottles and jars
- Plastic Containers: Water, soda and other containers with the recycle triangle and numbers 1-7
- California Redemption Value (CRV): bottles and cans with CRV or call (800) RECYCLE to find a recycle center near

What Goes into your Green Garbage Can?

- **Grass** and plant clippings, weeds, other small green waste items
- Food Waste (*Try composting to conserve!*)
- Non-hazardous waste
- Non-recyclable small items

Mandatory Commercial Recycling and Organic Waste

Per State law, businesses must have organic and recycling services.

Contact 209-538-5792 for information on how to start service.

Leaf & Limb Collection

- Limbs must be less than 4 feet in length and 6 inches in diameter.
 - Piles must be placed loosely in the street one week or less before your recycle service day.
 - Leaf and Limb Collection occurs one day after your recycling service day.
 - Grass clippings, weeds, and bark go in your Green Can
 - NO DIRT
 - NO TREE STUMPS
 - Please report **Illegal Dumping**: 209-538-5792.
