CITY OF CERES MEASURE H CITIZENS' OVERSITE COMMITTEE

The City is seeking residents to fill the five-member Committee seats.



About Measure H

During the November 2007 election, voters of the City of Ceres approved a 1/2-cent sales tax for the improvement of police, fire, and 9-1-1 emergency response services. The City Council passed Ordinance 2007-975 to implement this transactions and use tax.

The proceeds collected are placed in a special account designated only for Public Safety Services use in accordance with the Public Safety Expenditure Plan and shall supplement existing City expenditures.

About the Citizens' Oversight Committee

The Committee consists of five (5) members who serve as an advisory body and whose purpose is to monitor the expenditures of the revenue collected, and report to the People and City Council. Two (2) mandatory meeting per year are scheduled; may meet more often as needed.

Eligibility

Any resident of the City, except current City of Ceres employees, officials, contractors, or vendors, may serve on the committee. Past persons in these capacities may serve provided no conflict of interests exist as determined by the City Attorney.

Vacancies

The members are appointed by the City Council.

- Three (3) Members will serve a 3-year term, each (07/01/2022 to 06/30/2025)
- Two (2) Members will serve the remaining of a 3-year term
